We got 2 large collapses as we approached the crown of the <u>slide</u> on Wade's world in Fisher Creek, and another an hour later near Henderson Mtn. On Henderson Bench we could see 2 new avalanches that looked fresh, possibly <u>cornice</u> triggered. It was not windy, so windloading was not the <u>trigger</u>. Regardless, it was disconcerting. Across the Fisher Creek valley we could see a <u>slide</u> on the nose of Sheep Mountain on the same slope that killed a snowmobiler in 2015. [Avalanche details in separate record].
