On Henderson Bench we could see 2 new avalanches that looked fresh, possibly [cornice](#) triggered. It was not windy, so windloading was not the [trigger](#). Regardless, it was disconcerting. Across the Fisher Creek valley we could see a [slide](#) on the nose of Sheep Mountain on the same slope that killed a snowmobiler in 2015. [Avalanche details in separate record].
